



STUDENT LEADERSHIP AT REYNELLA PRIMARY SCHOOL

At Reynella Primary school we believe it is crucial to provide opportunities for students to influence the learning in and beyond the classroom and create a culture where everyone inspires and encourages each other's learning.

A Student Learning Community (SLC) brings together a group of students to focus on, inform and influence learning. They explore and promote new learning for peers, teachers and community and work collaboratively.

One student from each class from years 3-7 will be represented on each team. Executive Leadership Action Team will liaise with Junior Primary classes when necessary. Students will present their application to their class to be voted on by the end of week 2 term 1. All students need to be living our Mindsets for Learning and our School Agreements.

Student Action Teams meet Wednesday weeks 3, 6 and 9 each term, except term 4 and **Executive Student Leadership Team** meet in weeks 5 and 10 each term, except weeks 4 and 8 in term 4. All meetings will start at 9.00am.

The Executive Student Leadership Team reports to Governing Council and staff, they represent the school in Interschool Student Learning Community.
